

MINES & MEADOWS ATV RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Always wear your safety equipment; obey state, federal and manufacturer laws and regulations. DOT or SNELL approved helmets and protective eyewear must be worn at all times.
2. Travel is permitted on designated, blazed routes only. Off-trail travel may damage natural resources or pose a safety hazard to other users. Please respect the rights of others. Obey all signs, gates, barriers and security personnel; do not ride off Mines & Meadows property. Only enter and exit the trail system at a designated trailhead.
3. Speeds in excess of 25 mph are prohibited. Pay close attention to bends and pitches in the trail, and maintain speeds reasonable for conditions.
4. All children under the age of 16 must have direct adult supervision. Children under the age of 8 are not permitted to operate a vehicle.
5. It is the law to register your ATV in PA. Out-of-state registrations are honored for all states that have reciprocity Pennsylvania. PA registration applications can be obtained onsite at Mines & Meadows or by calling the PA DCNR Snowmobile/ATV Unit at (717) 783-9227.
6. You must have proof of insurance with you.
7. Riders must purchase either a yearly Gold Club Pass, a Seasonal Pass or a single use permit and have it displayed on their person at all times.
8. All adult riders must show a valid driver's license or other photo identification and sign a waiver before riding.
9. ATVs must have a properly functioning muffler (no racing mufflers) and USFS approved spark arrestor (90 decibel maximum).
10. No vehicle over fifty-five (55) inches in width is allowed on any trail.
11. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed or carried and no glass containers, littering or weapons of any kind are permitted in the park.
12. Permits for both fires and camping must be obtained at the park office.
13. No riding after dark. Trails are open from 9:00 a.m. to sunset.
14. Be aware of oncoming riders.
15. Violators of any above listed rules will be asked to leave with no refund.
16. Mines & Meadows complies with all provisions of the **State of Pennsylvania All-Terrain Vehicle Law.**
